The Lindo Theatre, designed by world famous Chicago architects and brothers, C.W. Rapp and George L. Rapp, opened on April 17, 1922. John Dittman, owner of several other Freeport theatres, constructed it. In September, 1984, Willis and Shirley Johnson purchased the theatre, and it became part of Classic Cinemas.
